Dear Fellow Employee,

Today was the start of elective surgical cases since the restriction was placed due to the COVID pandemic. There were 5 cases performed and all went well for the patients, surgeons, anesthesiologists and staff. The State will be issuing additional elective procedure guidelines soon which we will immediately adopt.

I am pleased to report that we have received \$800,000 from the Federal Government through the CARES program. This brings our total to date to \$1.8 million. As you know, this support is so badly needed and very much appreciated. There remains additional monies in the CARES program that is to be distributed to health care providers. We are not aware at this time how much or when those dollars will be distributed. My hope is soon as this allows us to continue to meet our financial obligations without the need to borrow funds. I want to assure everyone, we are doing all we can to reduce expenses as well as generate revenue. We have had success and will continue that focus for the foreseeable future.

We have now tested a total of 873 individuals, 734 negative, 88 positive and 51 pending with one death. We currently have 2 positive inpatients and 7 inpatients pending. We only received 6 results last night. 4 of those positive. 3 of the positives are outpatients and recovering at home.

Nothing new to report on PPE. I will know more tomorrow when our leadership team meets to discuss our inventory and current burn rate. Please stay vigilant in your efforts to conserve our PPE.

Thank you so much for all you are doing to meet our patients and residents needs.
