Dear Family Member,

Today, we conducted resident COVID testing and need to notify you that we did have a couple results come back positive. As I stated last week, the positive cases we are seeing are residents without any symptoms. Many times we are having residents who were previously positive but over 90 days ago, therefore being counted as a new case. Tomorrow we will start our weekly testing of employees.

I'd like to remind you of the protocols we have when we have confirmed resident cases in the facility. We will increase the symptom checks from once a day to three times a day. All residents who have been exposed to the positive residents will be isolated. All communal activities and dining will be canceled. Staff who care for those residents who are confirmed positive or suspected, will wear N95 respirators, eye protection, gowns and gloves. There will be more of an emphasis of proper hand hygiene and use of sanitizer.

Please be sure to wear your mask at all times, covering both your mouth and nose. There have been a few incidents recently that our staff have had to intervene when visitors were not wearing their face masks appropriately. The number of positive cases are on the rise once again across NY. Again, if you are not feeling well, or even have a cough, please refrain from visiting, and help us prevent the spread of COVID.
