I want to make you aware that there continues to be sporadic positive cases with both residents and staff. These cases are presenting very mild symptoms. Our residents are recovering with very little effects. In the past we have utilized monoclonal anti-body treatments when appropriate. Over the last couple of weeks, the government and the FDA has limited the use of those treatments due to their inability to fight the quickly rising BA.2 COVID strain. All the reports have stated it is extremely contagious but less severe than the previous strains. There are a couple different anti-viral medications that are proving to be very effective in reducing the symptoms of the virus.

As in my previous updates, we will continue to wear the appropriate PPE and exercise good hand hygiene. Staff and residents will continue to be tested regularly to identify potential sources of spread, as well as all visitors to our facility.
