With the Holiday Season here, I know you may consider shipping packages to your loved one at the facility. Please be sure the residents name and room number are on the package. This will help ensure packages are delivered timely and to the correct room. It is also a better idea to deliver the package to the ECF main entrance when possible. Deliveries are typically received at the loading dock and distributed throughout nursing home, hospital and all of our primary and specialty practices.
