Dear Fellow Employees,

The focus remains on getting the vaccine into people. We have 130 doses of the Moderna vaccine remaining and plan on having a Vaccine clinic on this coming Tuesday, starting at 7:00 a.m. This time, due to the limited number of vaccines and the fact that we will be opening to certain members of the community as directed by the State, you will need to register to receive the vaccine using our online registration process.

A link will be sent out by Kevin Prosser for you to register. Please be on the lookout for that today as well as tomorrow. Once the 130 doses are spoken for, we will need to turn off scheduling until such time that we are provided with additional doses of the vaccine.

Please note, for those of you who already had your first dose of the Moderna Vaccine at Oneida Health, you will be contacted regarding the dates that we will be offering for you to receive the second dose at Oneida Health. For employee's and medical staff, our plan is to offer those in the hospital proper rather than in the vaccine center. Being able to staff for potentially both vaccine locations will be the only obstacle to offering in the hospital. A communication will be sent this week to your manager who in turn will reach out to you with date and location for the second dose.
