Dear Fellow Employee,

I have previously circulated a "Special Update" concerning travel restrictions. This is the normal CEO update that I provide every Tuesday and Thursday.

Please note the following:

1. The new Visitor Response Plan has been implemented and some feedback has been received that needs to be addressed. We are being informed that not all visitors are abiding by the visitor restrictions that we have in place. We are now providing for each visitor and have available on each of the hospital units that allow visitors, guidelines that they must adhere to called "Do's and Don'ts." I have attached that for your information and for your use in the event that any of our visitors are not complying with our requirements. Please do not hesitate to tell them that they must abide by these guidelines or will be asked to leave the premises.
2. We reviewed our PPE inventory at the COVID Leadership Prep team meeting today. I am pleased to continue to report that our inventory is in good shape thanks to the cooperation from all of you over these months. We are still awaiting delivery of some small N95 masks which we hoped would be this week. We still do not have a delivery date so looking forward to possibly receiving that sometime in the next week or two. In the meantime, please continue to help us in this area as it is making a difference.
3. As of June 24, we have tested a total of 4274 individuals, 4000 negative, 153 positive with 121 pending. We received 54 results back as follows: Elective Procedures 29/0, Inpatient Testing 6/0, ED 2/0, Practices 15/0, ECF staff 1/0 and Employee Health 1/0. We currently have 0 COVID positive inpatients.

As of June 25, we have tested a total of 4320 individuals, 4137 negative, 153 positive with 30 pending. We received 137 results back as follows: Elective Procedures 1/0, Inpatient Testing 14/0, ED 2/0, Practices 12/0, ECF staff 105/0 and Employee Health 3/0. We continue with 0 COVID positive inpatients.

Please refer to my earlier email on the special update for those of you planning to travel as this will apply to you. We need to do our best to comply with this new Executive Order and continue to ensure the safety of our co-workers, patients and residents.

Thank you again for all you have been doing to provide a safe environment for all. Not all healthcare providers can say that.
